Priority is placed on housing homeless individuals and families quickly and providing intensive wraparound supports to achieve a healthy, stable and sustainable housing environment.

- Degree/Diploma in Human Services and experience in intensive case management, intervention, motivational interviewing, wrap around supports and advocacy (combination of related education/experience will be considered)
- Knowledge of Housing First principles, existing community resources and understanding of issues related to homelessness, including poverty, mental health and addictions
- Clear Police Information and CYIM checks
- Current Standard First Aid/CPR; ASIST Suicide Intervention
- Valid Alberta Driver's License, use of reliable vehicle and adequate insurance to carry passengers
